## THE CONFERRING OF THE DEGREES, *HONORIS CAUSA*

*For the Degree of Doctor of Humane Letters*  
**THE HONORABLE JAMES E. CLYBURN**  
The Candidate Will Be Presented by Ms. Leslie D. Hale  
*Vice Chair, Board of Trustees*

James E. Clyburn is the assistant Democratic leader in the United States House of Representatives and chairman of the Democratic Faith Working Group. He previously served in the post from 2011 to 2018 and served as majority whip from 2007 to 2010 and 2019 to 2022, making him the first African American to serve multiple terms as majority whip. A native son of South Carolina, Clyburn has represented the state's Sixth Congressional District since 1993.

Congressman Clyburn's humble beginnings in Sumter, South Carolina, as the eldest son of an activist, fundamentalist minister and an independent, civic-minded beautician, grounded him securely in family, faith, and public service. A 1961 graduate of South Carolina State, he began his professional career as a public-school teacher in Charleston, South Carolina. He later served as an employment counselor, and director of two youth and community development programs. In 1971, he joined the staff of Governor John C. West, becoming the first African American advisor to a South Carolina governor. In 1974 Governor West appointed him South Carolina human affairs commissioner where he served until 1992 when he retired from state government to run for Congress.

When he came to Congress in 1993, Congressman Clyburn was elected co-president of his freshman class. He was subsequently elected chairman of the Congressional Black Caucus as well as vice chair, and chair of the House Democratic Caucus. From 2011 to 2018, he served as assistant Democratic leader. In addition to serving as whip, Congressman Clyburn chairs the House Select Subcommittee on the Coronavirus Crisis.

Congressman Clyburn has led efforts to preserve and restore historic buildings on the campuses of historically Black colleges and universities (HBCUs). He sponsored legislation creating the South

Carolina National Heritage Corridor; the Gullah/Geechee Cultural Heritage Corridor; the Congaree National Park; the Reconstruction Era National Historical Park; and expanding the Brown v. Board of Education National Historic Site to South Carolina, Virginia, Delaware, and Washington, D.C.

Dedicated to making America's greatness accessible and affordable for all citizens, his 10-20-30 federal funding formula – initially applied to three programs in the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 – has been expanded to 15 accounts of the appropriations bills. Additionally, his Rural Energy Savings Program provides loans to families and businesses to implement durable, cost-effective energy efficiency measures. His “Accessible, Affordable Broadband for All” bill was included in the 2021 bipartisan infrastructure bill and is funded at a level of \$65 billion.

The recipient of 36 honorary degrees, Congressman Clyburn has numerous awards, including: the Lyndon Baines Johnson Liberty and Justice for All Award in 2015; the Harry S. Truman Foundation's Good Neighbor Award in 2021; and the NAACP's highest honor – the Spingarn Medal – in 2022. His endorsement of Joe Biden for president in 2020 is credited with boosting him to an overwhelming victory in the South Carolina and subsequent primaries and setting Biden on path to the presidency.

Congressman Clyburn and his late wife, Emily England Clyburn, met as college student protestors in an Orangeburg, South Carolina jail in 1960. The encounter led to a 58-year marriage, and they became parents of three daughters, grandparents to four grandchildren, and great grandparents to one great grandchild.

**MR. BRUCE A. KARSH**  
The Candidate Will Be Presented by Mr. Godfrey Gill  
*Member, Board of Trustees*

Bruce A. Karsh is co-founder and co-chairman of Oaktree Capital Management, a global alternative investment company with \$170 billion of assets under management. He is also chief investment officer and serves as portfolio manager for Oaktree's flagship opportunities funds and its multi-strategy credit funds. Bruce Karsh holds an A.B. in economics from Duke University (1977), and a J.D. from the University of Virginia School of Law (1980). Now a trustee emeritus of Duke University, Mr. Karsh served as trustee from 2003 to 2015, and as chairman of the board of DUMAC from 2005 to 2014.

Bruce Karsh and Martha L. Karsh, his wife of 43 years, founded the Karsh Family Foundation in 1998 which supports education, democracy, and community. Through the foundation, the Karsches have granted over \$400 million for education, professorships and scholarships, principally for undergraduate financial aid. At Duke

University, the undergraduate financial aid department is named after the Karsches. The Karsches have established major scholarship programs at Duke, the University of Virginia Law School, the University of Pennsylvania, Howard University, Spelman College, and Brown University. Two of them are top merit scholarship programs: the Karsh STEM Scholars Program at Howard University and the Karsh-Dillard Scholarships at Virginia Law School.

In 2021, the Karsches founded the Institute of Democracy at UVA. Martha and Bruce Karsh are major supporters of KIPP, Teach for America, Charter School Growth Fund, and UNCF.

In 2022, Howard University also announced a \$10 million gift from the Karsh Family Foundation to support the Graduation Retention Access to Continued Excellence (GRACE) grant.

**MS. MARTHA L. KARSH**

Martha L. Karsh is a graduate of the University of Virginia and Virginia Law School. She co-founded architectural and design firm Clark & Karsh and, in 2016, published “The Beatles A Hard Day’s Night: A Private Archive.” Martha Karsh currently serves on the national board of KIPP (Knowledge is Power Program) Foundation, co-chairs the bicentennial “Honor the Future Campaign for the University of Virginia,” and is a trustee emerita of the University of Virginia Law School Foundation.

She successfully led a \$70 million growth campaign for KIPP in Los Angeles. Martha Karsh and Bruce A. Karsh, her husband of 43 years, founded the Karsh Family Foundation in 1998 which supports education, democracy and community. Through the foundation, the Karshes have granted over \$400 million for education,

professorships, and scholarships, principally for undergraduate financial aid. At Duke University, the undergraduate financial aid department is named after the Karshes. The Karshes have established major scholarship programs at Duke, the University of Virginia Law School, the University of Pennsylvania, Howard University, Spelman College, and Brown University. **THE HONOURABLE KEITH CHRISTOPHER ROWLEY**  
The Candidate Will Be Presented by Mr. Mark A. L. Mason  
*Vice Chair, Board of Trustees*

Dr. Keith Christopher Rowley was born on October 24, 1949, in Mason Hall, Tobago, and was raised by his grandparents, who were prominent Tobago farmers. Dr. Rowley completed his secondary schooling at Bishop's High School (BHS) Tobago. His sterling academic performance captured the prestigious Sylvan Bowles Scholarship at BHS. He then commenced his studies at the University of the West Indies in Mona, Jamaica, from where he graduated with a BSc in geology (first class honours) and geography (first class honours); he also earned his MSc in volcanic stratigraphy at UWI, St. Augustine.

He is a volcanologist who obtained his doctorate in geology, specializing in geochemistry. He is a known nature lover, who enjoys gardening, hiking, and golfing.

As a research scientist, he held the positions of research fellow and later head of the Seismic Research Unit at the University of the West Indies, St. Augustine. He was also the general manager of state-owned National Quarries Company Limited.

He first ran for political office in 1981, where he contested the Tobago West seat. To date, Dr. Rowley has the distinction of being the only People's National Movement (PNM) candidate to have contested a seat in a general election in both Tobago and Trinidad.

Dr. Rowley is the member of the House of Representatives for Diego Martin West in the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago, where he has represented that constituency since 1991 having been re-elected in 1995, 2000, 2001, 2002, 2007, 2010, 2015, and 2020. Dr. Rowley first served in Parliament as an Opposition senator from 1987-1990. He later served at cabinet-level as minister of agriculture, lands and marine resources; minister of planning and development; minister of housing; minister of trade and industry; governor of the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB); and Trinidad and Tobago's representative governor of the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB).

Following the People's National Movement's defeat in the Trinidad and Tobago 2010 general election, Dr. Rowley was appointed leader of the Opposition of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago and was elected political leader of the People's National Movement in 2010. On September 7, 2015, Dr. Rowley led the People's National Movement to general election victory to become the seventh prime minister of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago. Dr. Rowley was re-elected to serve as prime minister on August 10, 2020, after winning the 2020 general election.

**DR. A. EUGENE WASHINGTON**

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Dr. Danette G. Howard

Dr. Eugene Washington (B.S. '72) has dedicated his entire career to improving the health and healthcare of the American people. An internationally renowned clinical investigator and health policy scholar, Dr. Washington has been a leader in assessing medical technologies, developing clinical practice guidelines, and establishing disease prevention policies, particularly in women's health. The thread that runs throughout all of this work is improving quality of healthcare and eliminating racial/ethnic disparities in health outcomes. His research and numerous publications have greatly impacted the practice of medicine in prenatal genetic testing, cervical cancer screening and prevention, noncancerous uterine conditions management, and reproduction-related infections. His executive leadership has inspired academic health systems to adopt public health principles as core to their mission. His service to the nation through professional and government boards and committees has emphasized the importance of health equity and community engagement in health policy and public discourse.

Dr. Washington has held academic leadership positions and senior executive posts in three prominent academic health systems. Currently, Dr. Washington is chancellor for health affairs at Duke University, where he also served as president and CEO of the Duke University Health System. Just prior to Duke, Dr. Washington served as vice chancellor of health sciences, dean of the David Geffen School of Medicine at the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA), and CEO of the UCLA Health System. At the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF), Dr. Washington served as executive vice chancellor and provost. There, he co-founded and directed the Medical Effectiveness Research Center for Diverse Populations, one of the first centers of excellence conducting research on health services for minority populations. Before joining the faculty at UCSF, Dr. Washington was an epidemiologist and clinical

investigator at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) in Atlanta.

Dr. Washington is known as one of the most vocal proponents in the U.S. of Academic Health Systems adopting health improvement as its ultimate mission, beyond the traditional missions of research, education, and patient care. At Duke University, he initiated and led the transition of Duke Medicine to Duke Health, which is today demonstratively more focused on socio-economic determinants of health and building healthy communities. At UCLA, Dr. Washington consolidated disparate and widespread projects into a comprehensive and organized community engagement entity that magnified the impact of these activities. And at UCSF, he strengthened the institution's commitment to service by building lasting partnerships with the community and by creating alignment across the entire enterprise.

Dr. Washington has also impacted the national health and healthcare agenda through his thought leadership. He was elected to the Institute of Medicine (IOM) (now the National Academy of Medicine) in 1997 and to the American Academy of Arts and Sciences in 2014. He chaired the boards of directors of the California HealthCare Foundation and The California Wellness Foundation, served on the board of trustees of the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, and was a director of Johnson and Johnson. Dr. Washington is founding chair of the board of governors of the Patient-Centered Outcomes Research Institute (PCORI), a national research organization authorized by the 2010 Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act. He currently serves on the boards of directors of the Kaiser Foundation Hospitals and Kaiser Foundation Health Plan, Inc.

Dr. Washington completed his undergraduate studies at Howard University, medical school at UCSF, graduate studies at UC Berkeley and at Harvard schools of public health, and residency training at Stanford University.

**MS. BENAREE PRATT WILEY**

Benaree Pratt Wiley (Bennie) is a corporate director and trustee. For 15 years, Wiley was the president and chief executive officer of The Partnership, Inc., an organization that strengthened Greater Boston's capacity to attract, retain, and develop talented professionals of color.

Wiley is currently a director on boards of the BNY Mellon Mutual Funds and CBIZ (NYSE: CBZ). She has served as the chair of PepsiCo's African American Advisory Board, and formerly served on the boards of Blue Cross Blue Shield of Massachusetts and First Albany (NASDAQ: FACT). Her civic activities include serving on the boards of Dress for Success Boston, Spaulding Hospital, the Black Economic Alliance, and formerly Howard University where she served as vice chair. In 2022, the National Association of Corporate Directors New England awarded Wiley the Director of the Year Award in Non-Profit Leadership.

She is a frequent speaker on leadership, diversity and professional development and has been the recipient of numerous awards and honors and four honorary doctorates including from Boston College and New England School of Law. Among her many honors are induction into the Academy of Distinguished Bostonians, the Pinnacle Award for Lifetime Achievement from the Greater Boston Chamber of Commerce, and Harvard Business School Distinguished Alumni Award from the African American Student Union.

Wiley also had the honor of being featured on the cover of Boston magazine as one of Boston's most powerful women; and being the subject of a Harvard Business School case, "Bennie Wiley and The Partnership."

In 2023, the Biden-Harris Administration appointed Wiley to the Presidential Advisory Commission on Advancing Educational Equity, Excellence and Economic Opportunity for Black Americans.

**THE HONORABLE JOSEPH R. BIDEN, JR.**  
THE 46<sup>TH</sup> PRESIDENT  
THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA  
The Candidate Will Be Presented by Dr. Laurence C. Morse

Joseph Robinette Biden, Jr. was born in Scranton, Pennsylvania, the first of four children of Catherine Eugenia Finnegan Biden and Joseph Robinette Biden, Sr. In 1953, the Biden family moved to Claymont, Delaware. President Biden graduated from the University of Delaware and Syracuse Law School and served on the New Castle County Council.

At age 29, President Biden became one of the youngest people ever elected to the United States Senate. Just weeks after his Senate election, tragedy struck the Biden family when his wife Neilia and daughter Naomi were killed, and sons Hunter and Beau were critically injured in an auto accident.

Biden was sworn into the U.S. Senate at his sons' hospital bedsides and began commuting from Wilmington to Washington every day, first by car, and then by train, in order to be with his family. He would continue to do so throughout his time in the Senate.

Biden married Jill Jacobs in 1977, and in 1980, their family was complete with the birth of Ashley Blazer Biden. A lifelong educator, Jill earned her doctorate in education and returned to teaching as an English professor at a community college in Virginia.

Beau Biden, attorney general of Delaware and Joe Biden's eldest son, passed away in 2015 after battling brain cancer with the same integrity, courage, and strength he demonstrated every day of his life. Beau's fight with cancer inspires the mission of President Biden's life – ending cancer as we know it.

As a senator from Delaware for 36 years, President Biden established himself as a leader in facing some of the nation's most important domestic and international challenges. As chairman or ranking member of the Senate Judiciary Committee for 16 years, Biden is widely recognized for his work writing and spearheading the Violence Against Women Act – the landmark legislation that strengthens penalties for violence against women, creates unprecedented resources for survivors of assault, and changes the national dialogue on domestic and sexual assault.

As chairman or ranking member of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee for 12 years, Biden played a pivotal role in shaping U.S. foreign policy. He was at the forefront of issues and legislation related to terrorism, weapons of mass destruction, post-Cold War Europe, the Middle East, and Southwest Asia.

As vice president, Biden continued his leadership on important issues facing the nation and represented our country abroad. Vice President Biden convened sessions of the president's cabinet; led interagency efforts; and worked with Congress in his fight to raise the living standards of middle-class Americans, reduce gun violence, address violence against women, and end cancer as we know it.

Biden helped President Obama pass and then oversaw the implementation of the Recovery Act – the biggest economic recovery plan in the history of the nation and our biggest and strongest commitment to clean energy. The president's plan prevented another Great Depression, created and saved millions of jobs, and led to 75 uninterrupted months of job growth by the end of the administration. And Biden did it all with less than 1% in waste, abuse, or fraud – the most efficient government program in our country's history.

President Obama and Vice President Biden also secured the passage of the Affordable Care Act, which reduced the number of uninsured Americans by 20 million by the time they left office and banned insurance companies from denying coverage due to pre-existing conditions.

He served as the point person for U.S. diplomacy throughout the Western Hemisphere, strengthened relationships with our allies both in Europe and the Asia-Pacific, and led the effort to bring 150,000 troops home from Iraq.

In a ceremony at the White House, President Obama awarded Biden the Presidential Medal of Freedom with Distinction – the nation's highest civilian honor.

After leaving the White House, the Bidens continued their efforts to expand opportunity for every American with the creation of the Biden Foundation, the Biden Cancer Initiative, the Penn Biden Center for Diplomacy and Global Engagement, and the Biden Institute at the University of Delaware.

On April 25, 2019, Biden announced his candidacy for president of the United States. Biden's candidacy was built from the beginning around three pillars: the battle for the soul of the nation, the need to rebuild the middle class – the backbone of our country – and a call for unity to act as One America. It was a message that would only gain more resonance in 2020 as we confront a pandemic, an economic crisis, urgent calls for racial justice, and the existential threat of climate change.

## **THE CONFERRING OF DEGREES IN COURSE**

*The order of presentation of Schools and Colleges for the conferring of degrees is based on two factors—the year of establishment of the School or College and the distinction between graduate/professional and undergraduate programs. The first six Schools and Colleges, beginning with the College of Arts and Sciences and ending with the College of Nursing and Allied Health Sciences, were established between the years 1868 to 1974. Undergraduate programs are predominant in these six Schools and Colleges. The next six Schools and Colleges, beginning with the College of Medicine and ending with the School of Social Work, were established between the years 1868 and 1945. These Schools and Colleges offer professional graduate level programs. The last School listed, the Graduate School, was established in 1934 and offers graduate-level programs exclusively.*

## THE MACE

THE MACE is the ceremonial symbol of the University and is carried by the University Marshal. One of the earliest visual images of the mace is the front-side of the “Narmer Palette” of Ancient Egypt, an oval-shaped cosmetic palette inscribed with human and anthropomorphic figures. King Narmer is depicted on the palette as a mighty conqueror wielding a mace over a symbolic enemy. King Narmer, also known as King Menes or King Midas to the ancient Greeks, unified Upper and Lower Egypt *circa* 3100 B.C., ushering in the great pyramid building of the old kingdom dynasties (c. 3000-2150 B.C.) of Imperial Egypt. At today’s Convocation, the entry of the mace heralds the arrival of the academic procession.

## THE BATON

THE BATON carried by the Marshals and Assistant Marshals of each School is being used to lead the academic procession of the respective Schools and Colleges into and out of the place of the ceremony. The batons are made of wood, painted blue, and tied with red, white and blue ribbons denoting the colors of Howard University.

## THE ACADEMIC DRESS

THE CAP, GOWN, AND HOOD worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted garb which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertips. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The Master’s degree gown is worn open, and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

Gowns for the Doctorate degree are also worn open. They carry broad, velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on the full, round sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

Mortar board or caps worn with Baccalaureate and Master’s gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

The blue Kente stole worn by the graduates was commissioned for the 1996 Commencement by the University and produced in Ghana. The stole depicts the Nkasewa pattern, which means eloquence, wisdom, and intelligence, and the symbol, Fi-Hankra, means safety, security, brotherhood, and solidarity.

Faculty members and guests in today’s procession are robed in gowns and hoods which represent the institutions from which they have received degrees.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains as follows: medicine, green; music, pink; nursing, apricot; pharmacy, olive green; public administration, peacock blue; science, gold yellow; social work, citron; theology, scarlet; architecture, blue violet; arts, letters, and humanities, white; business, drab; dentistry, lilac; education, light blue; engineering, orange; fine arts, brown; law, purple; and philosophy, dark blue.

## **THE HONOR MEDAL AND HONOR CORD**

THE HONOR MEDAL and HONOR CORD are worn by graduates who have achieved cumulative grade point averages making them eligible for the *cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, or honors. The Medal and Honor Cord symbolize that excellence is a hallmark of Howard University. The Medal was commissioned by Howard's President *Emeritus*, H. Patrick Swygert, for the 1996 graduating class. Its round shape is enhanced with a gold finish, symbolizing the eternal and universal value of excellence. The center of the seal asserts the mission of the University – "Truth and Service." Encircling the seal is the phrase, "Honors Graduate and Leadership for America," which heralds excellence and the contributions of Howard University to the nation. The silver Honor Cord symbolizes the high academic rank of *magna cum laude*. The gold Honor Cord worn by graduates symbolizes the highest academic rank of *summa cum laude*.

## **THE TORCH PIN**

THE TORCH PIN symbolizes that responsibility and excellence in leadership have been passed down and entrusted to the graduating seniors. It was commissioned by Howard's President *Emeritus*, H. Patrick Swygert, for the 1997 graduating class. Its round shape is enhanced with a gold finish, symbolizing the eternal and universal value of excellence. Encircling the seal is the phrase, "Howard University — Bearers of the Torch," which emboldens graduates to go forth in the Howard tradition to serve as beacons of hope and light in their respective communities.

## **THE UNIVERSITY'S HONORARY DEGREE MEDAL**

THE UNIVERSITY'S HONORARY DEGREE MEDAL, worn today by our distinguished honorary degree recipients, is formally presented to them at the annual Commencement Dinner held last evening in their honor at the Four Seasons Hotel in Washington, D.C. These medals commemorate the high esteem and honor bestowed upon them as honorary degree recipients at Howard University's Commencement Convocation.

## **THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE**

THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE, worn by President Wayne A. I. Frederick, was presented to the University on the occasion of the Centennial Celebration in 1967 by the late Trustee *Emeritus*, Herman B. Wells, and his late mother, Mrs. Granville Wells. It is a visible symbol of the Office of the President and has been worn by all presidents of Howard University, since 1967. The basic material of the chain is sterling silver, plated with hard gold. Both the University Seal and the Centennial Seal are appended to the chain.

Come to the place for which our fathers sighed?


